1. DRAW PERIOD:

Sierra Systems, an NTT Data Company Microsoft Canada Future of Operations Event in Calgary - Conference Prize Draw (the “**Draw**”) begins on January 29, 2019 at 8:00 a.m. Mountain Standard Time (“**MST**”) and ends on January 29, 2019 at 2:00 p.m. MST.
